3. Wear appropriate clothes and protective gear.
4. Inspect your snowmobile before your ride.
5. Bring a buddy.
6. Carry a first-aid kit, emergency kit and repair kit.
7. Stay alert.
8. Avoid frozen rivers.
9. Do not speed.
10. Stay on the trail.

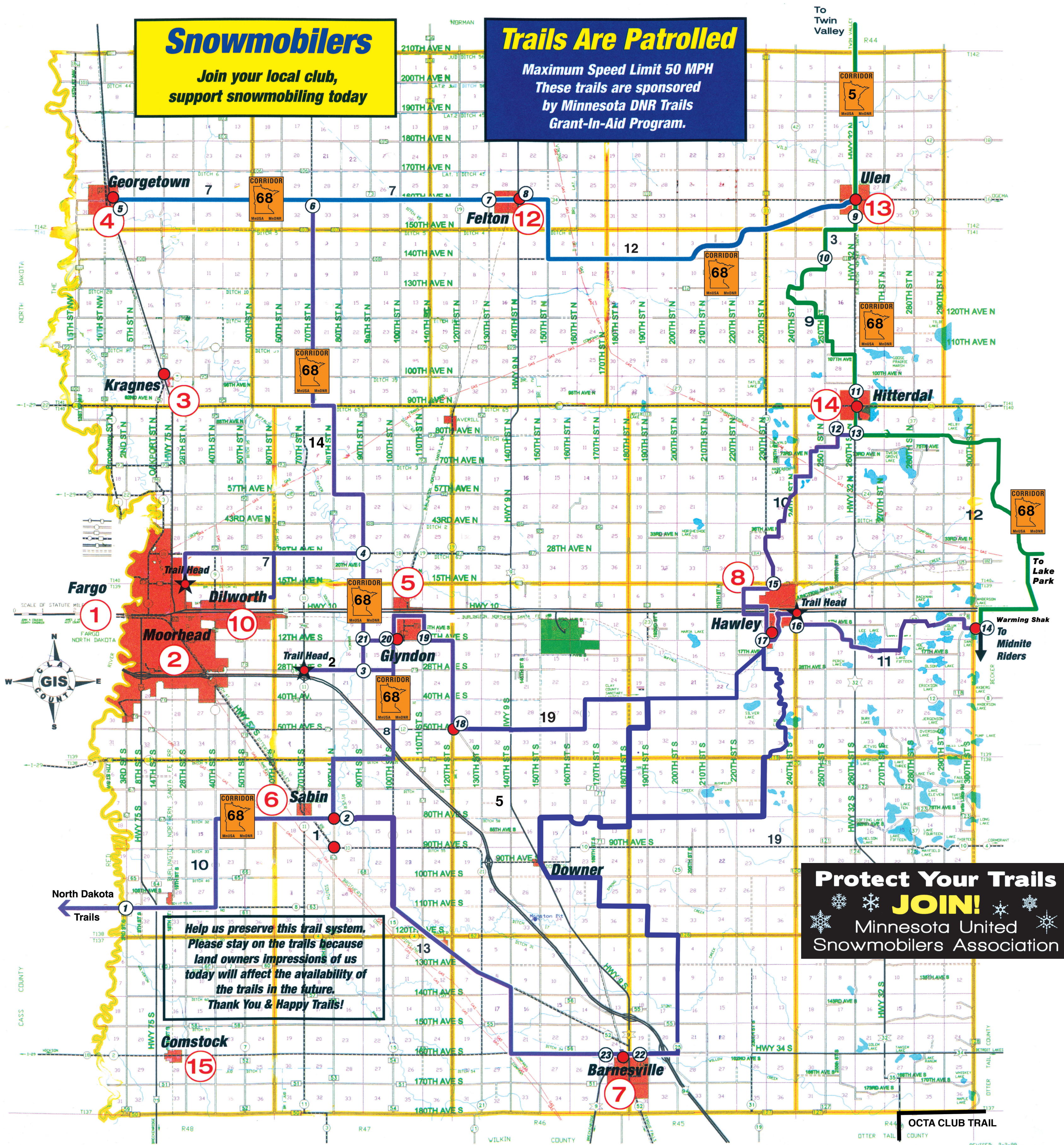
Trail System Map

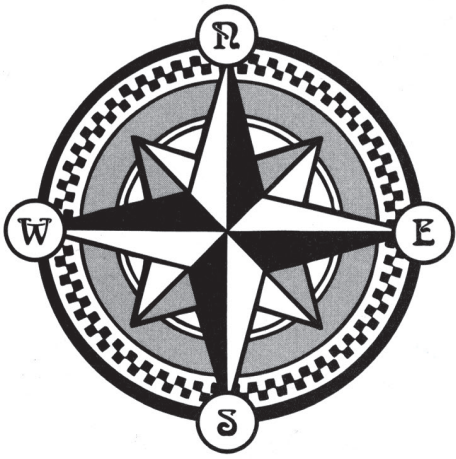

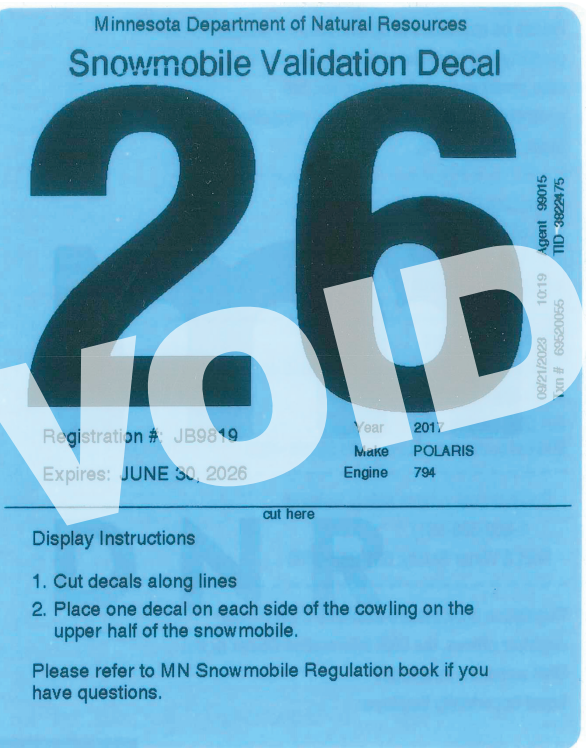

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

The State of Minnesota requires only a current registration on snowmobiles. At this time, you do not need a certificate of title for your snowmobile.

Two options for snowmobile registration:

- A snowmobile may now be registered for trail use or non-trail use.
- The trail use registration fee is \$113.50 for 3 years and includes unlimited use of Minnesota's 22,000 miles of state and grant-in-aid trails.
- The non-trail use registration fee is \$53.50 for 3 years and is not transferable. A snowmobile that is registered for non-trail use may NOT be operated on a state or grant-in-aid trail including a grant-in-aid trail in a road right-of-way.
- A non-trail use registration requires a new registration number to be affixed to the snowmobile.
- A state trail sticker is not valid for use on a non-trail use registered snowmobile.
- If an individual wants to use a non-trail use registered snowmobile on a state or grant-in-aid trail, the snowmobile will need to be re-registered for trail use and a new registration number will be assigned.
- A non-trail use registration decal will be yellow in color.

NEW IN 2014: SNOWMOBILE DEFINITION:

"Snowmobile" means a self-propelled vehicle originally manufactured and designed for travel on snow or ice steered by skis or runners. Snowmobile does not include the following vehicles equipped with aftermarket ski and track configurations: An all-terrain vehicle | An off-highway motorcycle | An off-road vehicle | A mini truck | A utility task vehicle, or any other vehicle being operated off road.



CAUTION

Trail use by motorized vehicles is prohibited. Please stay on marked trails. Pack out what you pack in. Cross all lakes, streams and rivers with extreme caution!

SAFETY

ALCOHOL AND SNOWMOBILING SIMPLY, DO NOT MIX

Forget that myth that alcohol warms up a chilled person. It opens the blood vessels, and removes the feeling of chill, but it does nothing to increase body heat. Instead, it can increase the risk of hypothermia, a dangerous lowering of the body's core temperature. With alcohol, you may feel warmer, while your body chills dangerously.

Alcohol increases fatigue, fogs your ability to make good decisions, and slows your reaction time. It's part of a formula for disaster. And don't forget most states and provinces have laws prohibiting the operation of a snowmobile while under the influence of alcohol.

AS A SAFE RIDER, YOU:

Know your abilities and don't go beyond them.
Know your riding area. Get a map. Talk to local folks.
Learn more-read manuals and other materials from manufacturers, administrators and snowmobile associations, or watch videos or computer programs from these sources. Snowmobile clubs, and state and provincial associations offer courses, information and activities. Many members are certified driving and/or safety instructors.

KEEP YOUR MACHINE IN TOP SHAPE

You have two good guides available for snowmobile maintenance: the owner's manual that came with it, and your dealer. Consult both to make sure your machine is kept in top form for dependable, enjoyable fun.
Your local club or association may also conduct safety and maintenance programs. Before each ride, follow the "pre-op" check outlined in your owner's manual.

DRESS APPROPRIATELY

Wear layers of clothing, so that you can add or remove a layer or two to match changing conditions. A windproof outer layer is especially important, as are warm gloves or mitts, boots and a helmet.
Make sure your helmet is safety-certified, the right size, and in good condition. A visor is essential for clear vision and wind protection, and the chin strap should be snug.
Wear glasses or goggles that offer protection from the sun.
